It certainly has already been shown that the quality and design are some of our hallmarks. When you decide to invest in a product from SPEKVA you can be sure that every little detail has been carefully selected, inspected and manufactured by hand.

We place great emphasis on craftsmanship and for decades have used a special method to join wood staves. Instead of gluing the staves flat side together, which is the most common, we join the staves by tongue and groove which are pressed together then glued. This allows up to 40% more surface area for the glue to bond, which prevents cracks from appearing later in time.

This method together with the best raw material provides an incredibly strong construction and a very long warranty of 30-years.

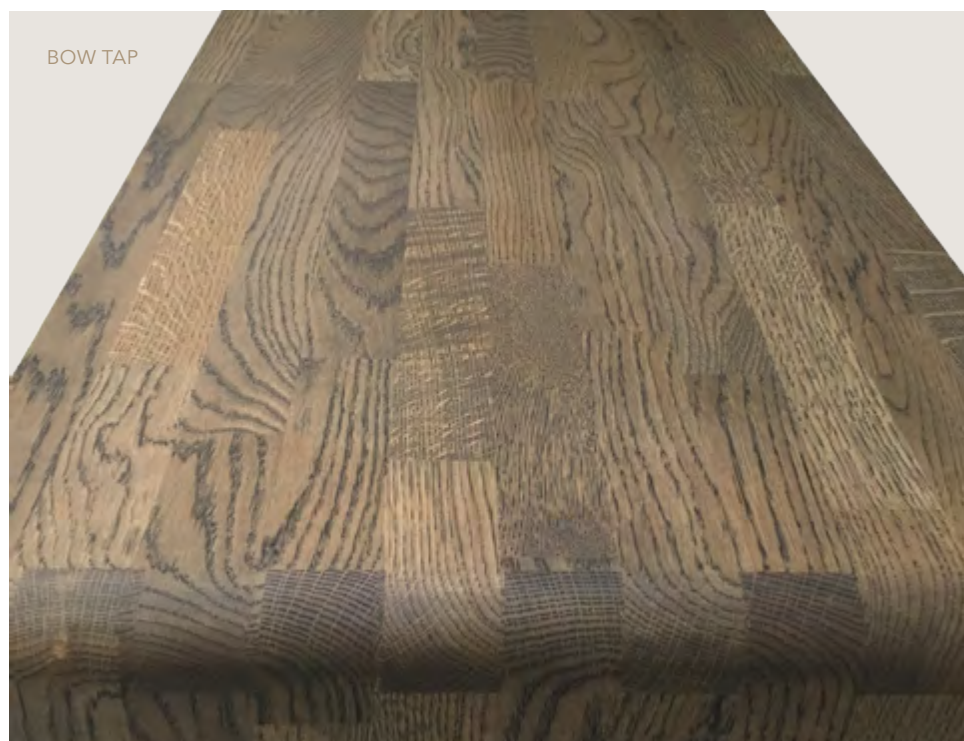
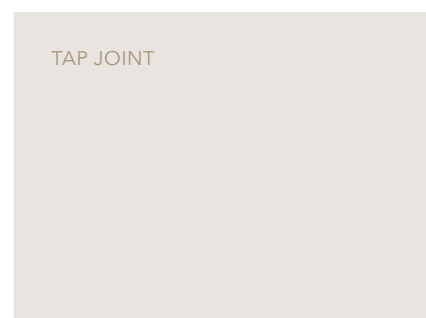
River washed

Our surface treatment 'river washed' applies the very in trend textured and tactile finish. By washing away the softer fibres in between the hard grain, it certainly accentuates the true natural character and honesty of solid wood. Almost as though the item has been salvaged from drifting down river.

This process is simply achieved by blasting particles of sand at the surface, and of course finished by hand at our factory in Vamdrup.

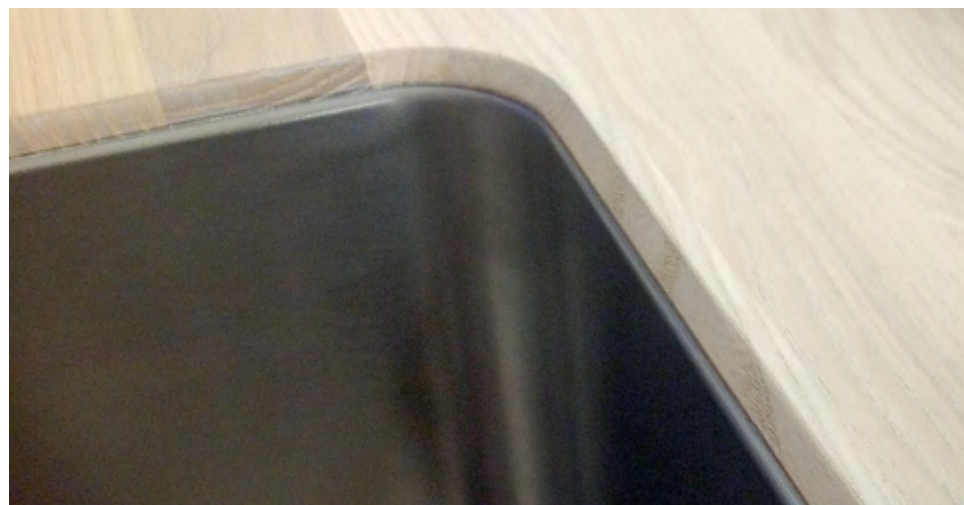

Engineered solid wood

The most eco friendly solid wood available today, Brasilica and Bavarian grow to full maturity in 25 years... a fraction in comparison to oak and walnut for example. The timber is fully FSC certified and sourced from man-made plantations. Once the trees have reached maturity, they are cut down and injected with a natural compound, which consists of proteins, amino acids and dye from ground down flowers.

This process converts an otherwise soft wood into a hard wood with the exact same density as oak. Brasilica and Bavarian are available in two different widths, and an incredible length of up 5.4 meters.



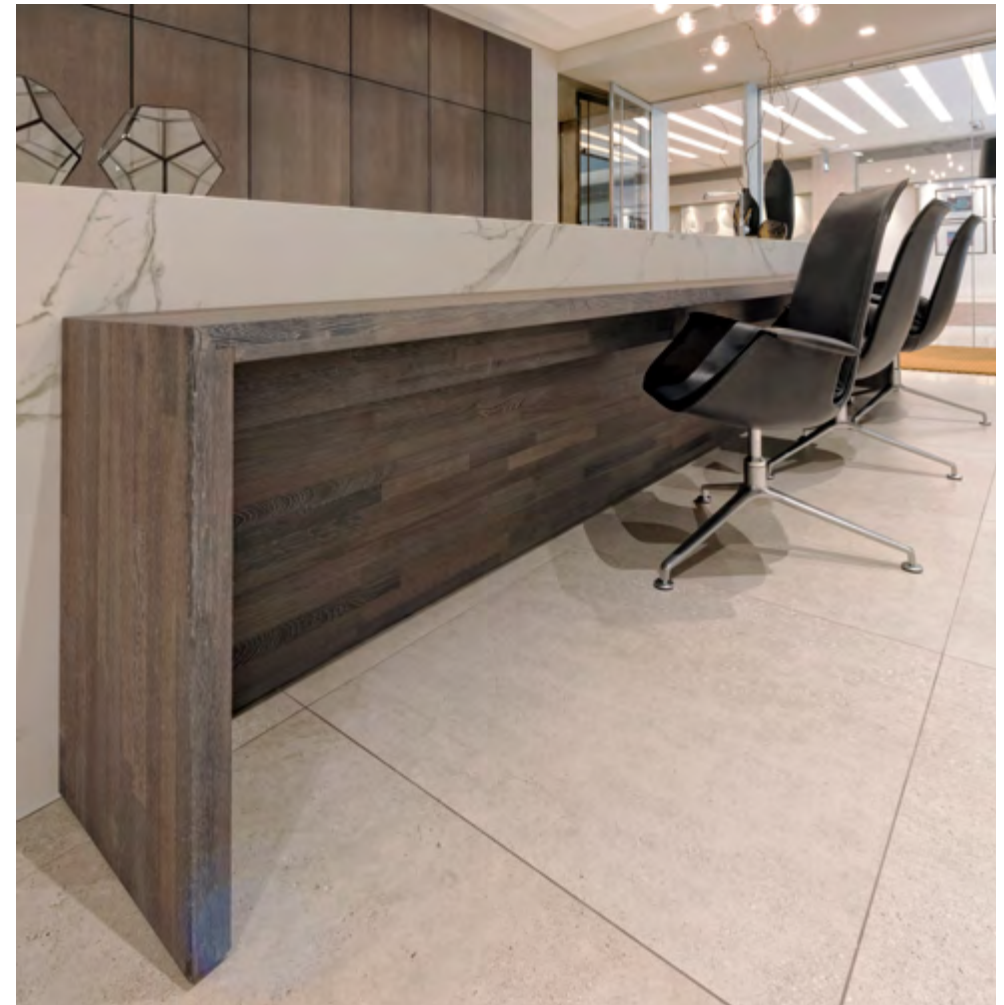

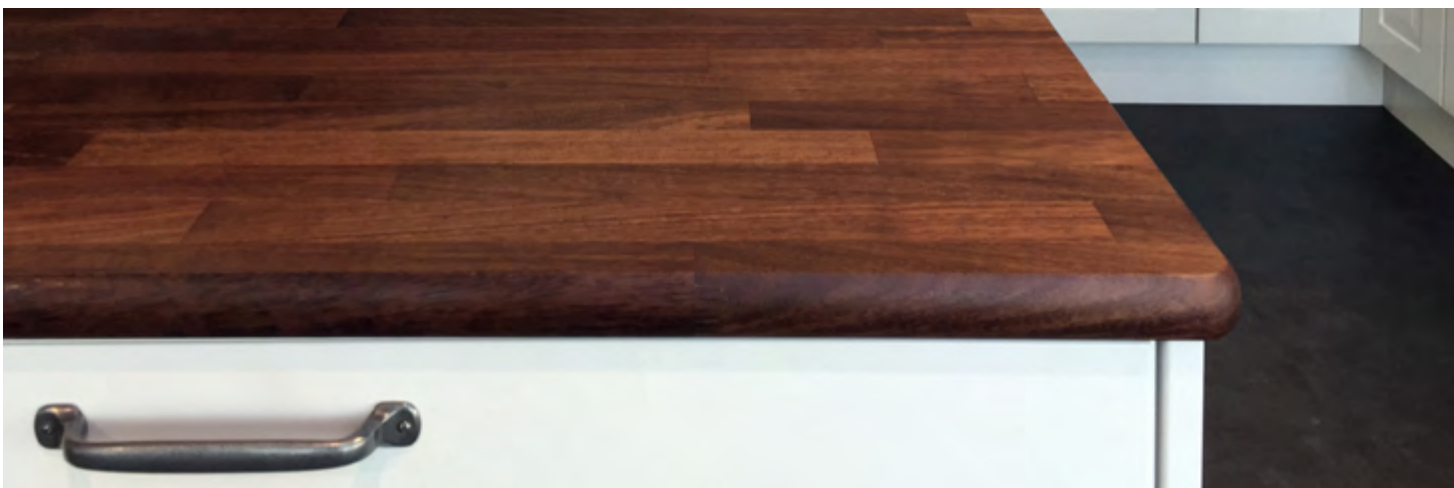

Environment and health

Nature is our main source. Here we pick up both inspiration and raw materials for our products. To show consideration and take responsibility for our environment has always been an important issue for us. As one of the first manufacturers in the world, we received in 2003 a global FSC certification. This means that we take responsibility for the replanting of felled forests, and target illegal timber trade.

Did you know that solid wood is an antibacterial material? When tests were carried out in a laboratory with house-hold bacteria such as salmonella and listeria, it's proven that the natural enzymes and acids found in solid wood kill bacteria. Solid wood treated with our natural oils are a perfect combination for a healthy food preparation area.
